This Wednesday, 29th of January, a mass for healing will be celebrated in English here in Rosary Church at 8 p.m. Special prayers will be prayed over the sick after Mass. All are welcome, especially those who feel in need of healing – either spiritually, emotionally or physically.

Saturday, 1st of February, is the First Saturday of the month. The First Saturday reparation devotion will begin with the 8 a.m. Mass in English, followed by recitation of five decades of the Holy Rosary and an Act of Consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.
